

The Fleet Art Society 2017 Outdoor drawing and painting activities

Please note there is no fixed programme for the day. People are welcome to come and leave at their own pace between 10am and 4pm

June 22nd Thursday	<p>Lodge Farm (Adjacent to Newlyn Farm Shop) RG29 1HA in North Warnborough</p> <p>Take A287 from Farnham direction to Odiham, take by-pass and at the end of the by-pass at roundabout at N. Warnborough, turn right towards “Lord Derby” pub & immediately right again signposted “LODGE FARM” & Newlyn Farm Shop. Continue down concrete road with passing places but fork left at Newlyn Farm Shop (Snack & coffee & toilets here) and carry on 150 yds next to the river and IMPORTANT to park on gravel triangle where track divides just before farmhouse & opposite large flower barns. Look out for a sign.</p> <p>No restrictions on where you can go, farm & walled gardens. Walk thru garden to bridge over R Whitewater for rear view of farmhouse. Old granary, some old tumbledown barns.</p> <p>BEWARE of farm traffic.</p> <p>Mrs Janaway is interested in art, so if she appears, do have a chat!</p>
July 4 th Tuesday	<p>Four Seasons Hotel Dogmersfield Park, Chalky Lane, Dogmersfield, Hampshire RG27 8TD</p> <p>http://www.fourseasons.com/hampshire/destination/directions_and_maps/</p> <p>Gardens, Restored Georgian house & Tundry Pond, and they are building an equestrian centre.</p> <p>Please park in the Guest Car Park unless you want to drive down to the pond. Park your car and let the staff know you are about. (They are expecting us.) Toilets in the Hotel</p>
July 12th Wednesday	<p>Old Rectory & Gardens, Bagwell Lane, Winchfield, Hook RG27 8DB (By courtesy of Mr George Adams)</p> <p>Proceed past the “Barley Mow” at Dogmersfield for about ¾ mile and turn left signposted “WINCHFIELD CHURCH”. At the church drive through the large gateposts on your right down a long drive to the far end. Before the house gates turn right through a gateway into the field next to the tennis courts.</p> <p>The Old Rectory, gardens and woodland are yours to explore.</p> <p>If this is not your scene, go back and park at the church and paint the church. Go through the churchyard and out the gate at the back to give you a very good view of the church.</p>
July 27 th Thursday	<p>Farnham Park and Castle, Castle Hill, Farnham, Surrey GU9 0AG</p> <p>Turn into the CP signposted for Farnham Park and Public Par 3 Golf Course and cricket ground. A short walk opens up great landscape / trees and attractive cricket pavilion. If you feel energetic Farnham Castle is only 10 mins walk away.</p> <p>Free parking for 95 cars at the castle, 10 meters from entrance. If you drive only park in the visitors CP. We are asked NOT to picnic on the front lawns or rose gardens but you can either picnic on the keep or other public seating areas. There is a good cafe at the Par 3 golf course and here are Public Toilets.</p>

<p>August 8th Tuesday</p>	<p>Selborne Village and Common Free parking in High Street behind Selborne Arms GU34 3JR.</p> <p>Selborne is a village just within the extreme northern boundary of the South Downs National Park. Beautiful thatched roof cottages along Gracious Street. The breathtaking bird-eyes view of the village on top of the Zig-zag Path starts by the Selborne Arms.</p>
<p>August 16th Wednesday</p>	<p>Portchester Castle Free parking and toilet outside the castle gate at Castle Street PO16 9QW</p> <p>Ticket to the castle is £5 for adult and £4 concession. However access to the surrounding area including the nearby ancient St Mary church is free. Details can be found on their website http://www.visit-hampshire.co.uk/things-to-do/portchester-castle-p44313</p>
<p>Aug 24th Thursday</p>	<p>Tylney Hall Hotel, Rotherwick, Hook, RG27 9AZ http://www.tylneyhall.co.uk/history-tylney-hall</p> <p>A30 thru Hook then turn right to Newham then follow road round to right towards Rotherwick. Follow the brown coloured Tylney Hotel signs to Tylney Hotel. Please park in the visitors CP only.</p> <p>Stunning buildings, Italianate gardens and water gardens and lake with a bridge and much more. There are some gazebos of the weather is inclement. There are about 65 acres here so suggest you get a map from the Reception.</p> <p>If the weather is wet and there is a need to use the toilets in the hotel we are asked to have a change of footwear to avoid muddying their carpets.</p> <p>(Toilets in hotel)</p>
<p>Aug 29th Tuesday</p>	<p>Cron dall Church and Village scenes, Cron dall, Farnham GU10 5QF</p> <p>There is usually room to park near the church. A short walk will take you to the Plume of Feathers and beautiful cottages (T at the Plume)</p>
<p>Sept 6th Wednesday</p>	<p>Basingstoke Canal Visitor Centre, Mytchett Place Rd., Mytchett GU16 6DD</p> <p>Canal scenes, usually 3 or 4 barges and a nice café & toilets.</p> <p>Cove Rd to Farnborough clocktower roundabout. Proceed straight over down Rectory Rd then turn right into Coleford Bridge Rd. Cross over 2 roundabouts (over Blackwater Valley Relief Rd) & keep on Coleford Bridge Rd crossing the Mytchett Rd. As soon as you cross the canal bridge look for signs immediately on left for Canal Visitor Centre.</p>
<p>Sept 14th Thursday</p>	<p>Elvetham Hotel, Hartley Wintney. RG27 8AR</p> <p>Online direction to the hotel http://www.elvethamhotel.co.uk/find-us</p> <p>An old favourite with gardens water features, river, rose gardens, bridge and glorious buildings.</p> <p>Turn off the Fleet to Hartley Wintney Road and park in Visitors CP only. Only restriction, don't go on the patio. Otherwise no restrictions. (T)</p>
