Please note there is no fixed programme for the day. People are welcome to come and leave at their own pace between 10am and 4pm

June 20 th Wednesday	<p><u>Four Seasons Hotel</u>, Chalky Lane Dogmersfield. RG27 8TD</p> <p>Gardens, Restored Georgian house & Tundry Pond, and they are building an equestrian centre.</p> <p>Please park in the Guest Car Park unless you want to drive down to the pond. Park your car and let the staff know you are about. (They are expecting us.) Toilets in the Hotel</p>
June 27 th Wednesday	<p><u>All Saints and St Mary's Church</u> and Village scenes, Croft Lane, Crondall, Farnham GU10 5QF</p> <p>There is usually room to park near the church. A short walk will take you to the Plume of Feathers and beautiful cottages (T at the Explorers Tea Room opposite to the Church. Fresh cut sandwich and home bake cakes at very reasonable price)</p>
July 10 th Tuesday	<p><u>Old Rectory & Gardens</u>, Bagwell Lane, Winchfield, Hook RG27 8DB (By courtesy of Mr George Adams)</p> <p>Proceed past the "Barley Mow" at Dogmersfield for about ¾ mile and turn left signposted "WINCHFIELD CHURCH". At the church drive through the large gateposts on your right down a long drive to the far end. Before the house gates turn right through a gateway into the field next to the tennis courts.</p> <p>The Old Rectory, gardens and woodland are yours to explore.</p> <p>If this is not your scene, go back and park at the church and paint the church. Go through the churchyard and out the gate at the back to give you a very good view of the church.</p>
July 18 th Wednesday	<p><u>Basingstoke Canal Visitor Centre</u>, Mytchett Place Rd., Mytchett GU16 6DD</p> <p>Canal scenes, usually 3 or 4 barges and a nice café & toilets.</p> <p>Cove Rd to Farnborough clocktower roundabout. Proceed straight over down Rectory Rd then turn right into Coleford Bridge Rd. Cross over 2 roundabouts (over Blackwater Valley Relief Rd) & keep on Coleford Bridge Rd crossing the Mytchett Rd. As soon as you cross the canal bridge look for signs immediately on left for Canal Visitor Centre.</p>
July 31 th Tuesday	<p><u>Elvetham Hotel</u>, Hartley Wintney. RG27 8AR</p> <p>An old favourite with gardens water features, river, rose gardens, bridge and glorious buildings.</p> <p>Turn off the Fleet to Hartley Wintney Road and park in Visitors CP only. Only restriction, don't go on the patio. Otherwise no restrictions. (T inside hotel)</p>
August 8 th Wednesday	<p><u>The Barley Mow</u> canal scenes and cottages</p> <p>Free car park at Sprat's Hatch Lane RG27 8ZY.</p> <p>Toilet at Barley Mow pub, Pale Lane RG27 8DE. Pub food are good quality and reasonable priced.</p>
Aug 22 nd Wednesday	<p><u>Selborne Village and Common</u>. Free parking in High Street behind Selborne Arms GU34 3JR.</p> <p>Selborne is a village just within the extreme northern boundary of the South Downs National Park. Beautiful thatched roof cottages along Gracious Street. The breathtaking bird-eyes view of the village on top of the Zig-zag Path starts by the Selborne Arms.</p>

<p>Aug 28th Tuesday</p>	<p><u>Lodge Farm</u> (Adjacent to Newlyn's Farm Shop) in North Warnborough RG29 1HA</p> <p>Take A287 from Farnham direction to Odiham, take by-pass and at the end of the by-pass at roundabout at N. Warnborough, turn right towards "Lord Derby" pub & immediately right again signposted "LODGE FARM" & Newlyn's Farm Shop. Continue down concrete road with passing places but fork left at Newlyn's Farm Shop (Snack & coffee & toilets here) and carry on 150 yds next to the river and IMPORTANT to park on gravel triangle where track divides just before farmhouse & opposite large flower barns. Look out for a sign.</p> <p>No restrictions on where you can go, farm & walled gardens. Walk thru garden to bridge over R Whitewater for rear view of farmhouse. Old granary, some old tumbledown barns.</p> <p>BEWARE of farm traffic.</p>
<p>Sept 6th Thursday</p>	<p><u>Tylney Hotel</u>, Rotherwick, Hook RG27 8AZ http://www.tylneyhall.co.uk/history-tylney-hall</p> <p>A30 thru Hook then turn right to Newham then follow road round to right towards Rotherwick. Follow the brown coloured Tylney Hotel signs to Tylney Hotel. Please park in the visitors CP only.</p> <p>Stunning buildings, Italianate gardens and water gardens and lake with a bridge and much more. There are some gazebos of the weather is inclement. There are about 65 acres here so suggest you get a map from the Reception.</p> <p>If the weather is wet and there is a need to use the toilets in the hotel we are asked to have a change of footwear to avoid muddying their carpets.</p> <p>(Toilets in hotel)</p>
<p>Sept 11th Tuesday</p>	<p><u>Upton Grey Village</u> RG25 2RL</p> <p>From Odiham village proceed to Upton Grey where by kind permission, we can park in back of the car park, the grass part through a gate, of the "Hoddington Arms" pub on the Bidden Road. Please keep the front free for customers.</p> <p>Lovely village scenes of thatched cottages, village pond, farm buildings etc.</p> <p>Why not all meet up for some lunch/refreshment in the Hoddington Arms about 12.45 pm to say thank you to the pub for allowing parking.</p> <p>Toilets in the pub.</p>
